Run Away, Cyber Crime Suspect Taken By Force

The first cyber crime case in provincial court (Pengadilan Negeri) Denpasar was not running well.

The suspect, Sang Ayu Made Karnasih (33), who was called to appear at court for 3 months by prosecutor (Jaksa Penuntut Umum), Suhadi S.H, never come to the court.

Therefore, he asked Bali Police to arrest Karnasih and force her to attend the session in court, yesterday, Wednesday (15/6/2005).

In his indictment, the prosecutor said that she's is operating internet business or specifically Internet Service Provider (ISP) without license from the ministry.

Karnasih's Company named CV. Candi Internet, which is operating a web site named www.candiinternet.com is located on Jl. Raya Seminyak, Seminyak, Kuta.

About the regulation; the accused doesn't have a license, so the prosecutor charges for violation of Telecommunication law no.36 from 1999. The first charge is: Karnasih violated the law of chapter 47 KUHP unto chapter 11 verses 1 Telecommunication law.

The second charge is: chapter 32 KUHP unto 32 Telecommunication law.

After the prosecutor read his indictment, the judge, Sudia, decided to arrest Karnasih in the prison of Kerobokan.

The judge decided to delay witness investigation until next week.
